On August 23, 2007 Bill Long and Christine Jewitt had the opportunity to present the topic “New York’s Serious Injury from the Claims Perspective” at Laidlaw International, Inc.’s claims office in Arlington, Texas. The lecture focused on what constituted a qualifying serious injury under New York’s No-Fault Law. The discussion included a detailed analysis of the nine (9) categories under which a claimant asserts a serious injury claim, the evidence upon which threshold claims must be based and the current state of the New York Courts application of what it considers to be a serious injury under the No-Fault threshold legislation.
